North Park Police would like to remind residents that there is a city ordinance that states property owners are required to keep all sidewalks clear of snow. City ordinance 11-309: *Removal of Snow. (A) It shall be unlawful for the owner, occupant, lessor, or agent of any property, abutting on a paved sidewalk to fail to remove, or have removed from such paved sidewalk, all hail, snow, or sleet thereon within a reasonable time after such snow, hail, or sleet has fallen. In the case of a storm between the hours of 5 pm and 6 am such sidewalks shall be cleaned before 9 am of the same day.* North Park Police ask that you do your part to keep people safe by not having to walk in the street especially our youth as they walk to and from school.
