**GREEN WASTE**

Logan City Environmental Department will be limiting their green waste services going forward. As such, the Green Waste bins at Elk Ridge Park will only be available April 6th - May 1st, and October 5th - November 1st. With these changes we need to remind citizens to never dump green waste on the ground. This is considered littering and individuals who dump on the ground will receive a citation. If the green waste bins are full, or absent during the summer months, please take your green waste to the Logan Landfill. There is no charge for green waste.

The library has been called upon to support our City, State, and Federal Government to mitigate the spread of COVID-19 in our community.
