## EMERGENCY INFO - "COMMUNITY CONNECT"

Have you ever wondered if the fire department knows essential information that may help save your family, pets, or property? Community Connect can make that possible. Community Connect is a secure, easy to use platform that allows residents to self-report critical information about their household to aid first responders and emergency service personnel to respond more efficiently and effectively; ultimately resulting in better incident outcomes.

Community Connect is completely voluntary, and residents decide which information they are comfortable sharing with first responders. Residents simply create a profile and enter critical information for public safety agencies at the time of dispatch. Data provided by residents within Community Connect is 100% secure and is used only for the purpose of better serving the residents during emergency situations.

## GOVERNMENT MEETINGS (Agendas: [pmn.utah.gov](http://pmn.utah.gov))

**The City Council Meeting will take place on Wed., December 9th.** The City Council will be considering a bid to replace the lights at the Library. In addition, there may be a consideration of a new ordinance related to short term rentals, and an amendment to the Four Seasons South Development Agreement.

**The Planning Commission Meeting will take place Thurs., December 10th.** The Planning Commission will be discussing a subdivision of property at 2600N Wolf Pack Way. They will also be considering a positive recommendation of the Pre-Disaster Mitigation Plan that was prepared by the Bear River Association of Governments.

## GREEN WASTE

In order to cover the costs of the green waste bins at Elk Ridge West, The Cache Solid Waste Advisory Board, along with Logan Environmental have opted to assess a \$1/month fee on all utility accounts starting in January of 2021. This fee increase will be included in your monthly garbage bill. Logan Environmental has also committed to providing a third bin at Elk Ridge West this coming summer. ## NORTH PARK POLICE

**Winter parking** restrictions are in effect. Please be sure to have your **vehicles off the streets** so the plow drivers can keep the roads clear of snow this winter. North Park Police officers will be issuing citations if you are in violation of the following code:

### 11-604 Winter Street Maintenance-Overnight Parking

**Prohibited** No person shall park a vehicle on any roadway or city-owned parking lot without it being attended by someone able to immediately remove the same between the hours of one o'clock (1:00) a.m. and five o'clock (5:00) a.m. of any day, **beginning November 15 and ending the last day of February of each year**, except health care professionals and/or emergency support personnel during emergency calls.

## WATER DEPARTMENT

Protecting your home's backflow assembly helps North Logan keep our drinking water protected. A broken backflow assembly could allow backflows to happen, which could contaminate our water system. Now that cold weather has arrived, be sure to have your culinary irrigation lines blown out. This will help keep your backflow assembly from freezing and breaking. We also recommend insulating your backflow assembly as an added level of protection. Do your part to keep our water safe!

## STORMWATER

- Clean/sweep parking lots to prevent debris run-off.
- Inspect & clean inlets and catch basins of any debris.
- Install oil/water separators, chemical separators, snouts, or other appropriate filtration devices.
- Limit the amount of pesticides/herbicides applied to lawn, park strips, and landscaped areas.
- Eliminate excessive use of fertilizers.
- Sweep up excess fertilizer.
- Verify that wash bay facilities drain to sanitary sewer.
- Minimize de-icing salts or use alternate methods.
