The last few months we have made several adjustments within the city to deal with COVID-19. One of those adjustments has been how we meet as a City Council. We have had several virtual meetings with most attendees at their homes. The meetings have been streamed live. Starting on May 20th we have been able to meet together again at the library. I hope we will be able to continue to provide a live stream of the public meetings for those who like to watch from home.

If you have been able to watch some of these meetings online you have noticed we are in budget season. Each year it's tough to make a budget balance in the city. There are many demands for city services, with ever increasing cost. This year we have seen significant increases in the cost of providing fire and EMS services. Added to that is a likely decrease in sales tax revenue, because of COVID-19. North Logan City Council has considered the possibility of a tax increase. Utah has a unique property tax method with Truth-in-Taxation, which I would be happy to discuss in detail with anyone interested.

As a city councilman I strive to spend less and not increase taxes. There are many difficult decisions to be made about which services and projects to maintain. I am committed to providing the essential services to the citizens of North Logan. We appreciate the patience and continued support from the citizens of North Logan with the changes we have been dealing with.

With these changes we need to remind citizens to never dump green waste on the ground. This is considered littering and individuals who dump on the ground will receive a citation.
