

MAYOR'S MESSAGE

Fall is a wonderful season in North Logan. With school back in session, please remember to keep an extra eye out for school children coming to and from school. Our two elementary schools in town both have a significant share of kids who walk to school. We are excited to have a traffic light at the intersection of 2500 N and Wolf Pack Way. We believe this will make things much safer for our community, especially our young drivers as they navigate to and from Green Canyon High School.

I'd also like to thank everyone for their support in responding to our water conservation measures in this summer's historic drought. We're not out of the woods yet, but with continued conservation measures, we'll be fine as summer gives way to the cooler temperatures of fall and outdoor watering (which comprises a majority of our city's summer water use) declines. The city revamped our water master plan pre-drought and is working to finalize plans to increase our water supply with a new well and additional reservoir storage tanks so that we can move forward with construction. These improvements will improve our city's water security for years to come, but water for virtually everyone in Utah will still depend on good snowpack in the winters.

NORTH PARK POLICE

There has been a rise in vehicle burglaries and vehicle thefts. The City Council Meetings will take place on Wednesdays, September 1st and 15th, at 6:30 p.m. In September, the City Council will consider reducing setback distance requirements in the Manufacturing and Heavy Commercial Zone, along with an ordinance modifying the city's method of disposing of surplus property. There will also be a consideration of the signing of an agreement regarding the shared sewer trunkline between North Logan and Logan City.

The Planning Commission Meetings will take place on Thursdays, September 2nd and 16th, at 6:30 p.m. The Planning Commission will continue their discussion of updates to the General Plan. In addition, there will be discussion of an ordinance related to the post division approval process of improper subdivisions.

WATER

Culinary Water Conservation Measures September 2021

Requirements:

- **Odd addresses are permitted to water on Mondays and Thursdays. Even addresses are permitted to water on Tuesdays and Fridays.** No watering on Wednesdays, Saturdays, or Sundays.
- **Residences that utilize secondary water are prohibited from switching to culinary water for lawn watering for the remainder of the water season.**

Please turn off your sprinkler clocks during rain events. Violations will be assessed for watering on the wrong day of the week and for watering during rain events. Secondary users please follow your line managers requirements and/or the requirements of the canal company. Please Check the North Logan City Website for updates on Water Conservation Measures. These restrictions may change in mid-September depending on precipitation amounts and water usage.

STORMWATER

Through the summer and fall we want to remind you not to use the roadway as a staging area for landscape materials. Not only is this hazardous for drivers and pedestrians, it pollutes our waterways.
