



How would you compare your level of awareness about City services, meetings, events, and news now compared to a year ago?






Do you know how to access city council and planning commission meeting agendas, minutes, and/or livestream links?









What park facilities and park amenities would you like to see added in North Logan City?









# Areas Where we Need to Place More Emphasis and Improve

- Trails/Paths/Sidewalks (Connectivity) Especially the canal trails, 1600E paved path, BST.
- General Plan (Including Community Surveys, Control Growth, Preserve Open Space)
- Recreation Center/Pool
- Communication
  - Use email more often (Get more people signed up for Parlant, Agendas...etc).
  - Get more people signed up for social media (do more posts, as well).
- Economic Development (More retail, restaurants, recreation).
- Road Striping
- More policing near schools, training for officers, and community outreach (Chief has these already in the works).
- Code enforcement officer. See list of nuisances (Weeds, Junk/Clutter, Inoperable Cars, RV's cars parked on roads, dangerous buildings or structures, construction noise).
- See list of requested recreation programs (Pickleball, Senior Programs, Adult Programs).
- More parking at Parks.

- Potholes (cold mix)
- No control over new school construction (City Council can't even consider how schools will be affected by new subdivisions).
