Frequently Asked Questions

Why am I running?

I am concerned about the direction the city is headed as indicated by the survey they sent out earlier this year.

One aspect was proposing the city fund a recreation center through an increase in property tax.

Entertainment is not the role of government. Hence, North Logan City should leave a recreation center up to a private entity and keep out of competition with the private sector. Property tax has been increasing, and with the current inflation situation, the city should not be adding to the burden.

How can there be a focus on preservation and still respect private property ?

It will take creativity, innovation, and a desire to try —and I have all three! Currently, there doesn't even seem to be an interest in keeping North Logan a small town. The current master plan talks about how North Logan enjoys and wants a rural feel, but nothing is in place to protect it. There is less than 4% of land in North Logan reserved for agriculture.
